At inVIVO financialSM, your privacy is very important to us. We respect the privacy of our contracted clients, our inquiring visitors, and our general visitors landing on our website. We do not collect personally identifying information without our client's permission. inVIVO financial does not share your personal information outside of the inVIVO financial family of companies (inVIVO financial, inVIVO credit, inVIVO tax, inVIVO realty, inVIVO insurance and inVIVO mortgage) for promotional use.

Our Security Procedures

inVIVO financial understands the importance of protecting and securing information, and using it appropriately. Information We Collect

We collect and store information that you voluntarily provide to us as well as data related to your Web Site visit and usage. We collect personally identifiable information (including, but not limited to, name, address and phone number) that is voluntarily provided to us by you.
